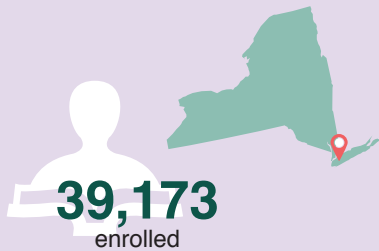
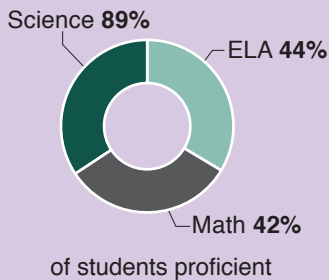
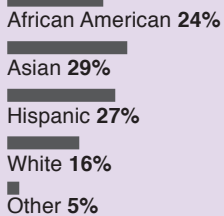

Project Overview

New York City (NYC) Community School District 28 is converting three elementary schools and one middle school into whole-school magnet programs. These Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)–funded schools expand the district’s school choice options and support the development, implementation, and refinement of high-quality, interdisciplinary thematic curricula. The programs use state-of-the-art technology to promote rigorous, engaging, and exploratory learning environments; use research-based instructional strategies to foster student achievement; and increase family engagement and partnership opportunities. 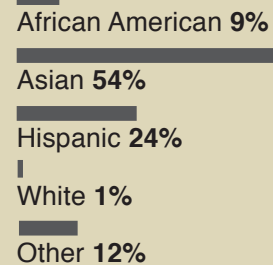

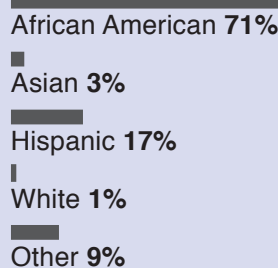

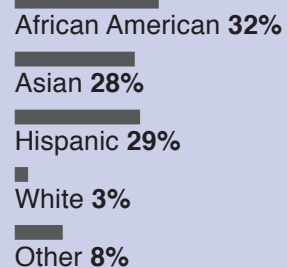
