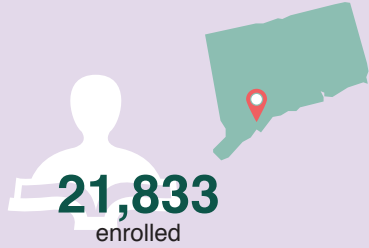
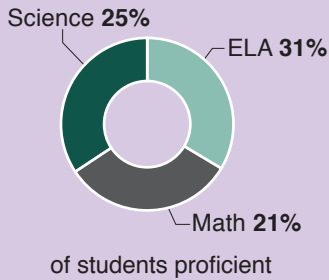
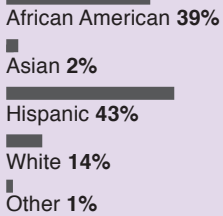

## Project Overview

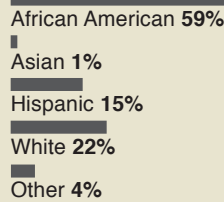

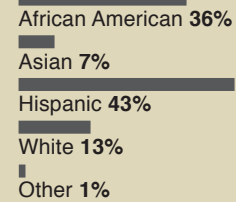

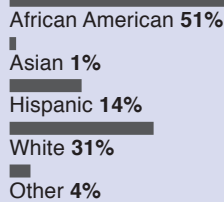

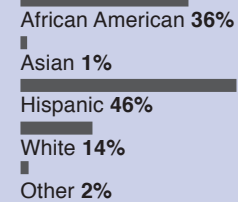

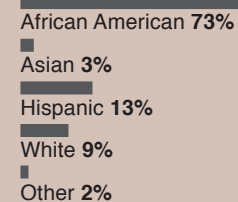
