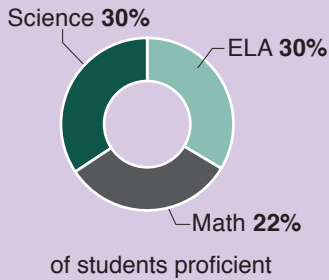
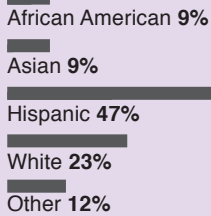

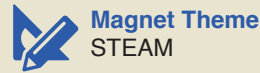


Project Overview

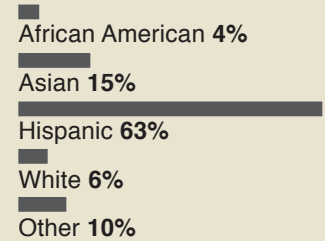
San Diego Unified School District is converting three traditional schools into whole-school magnet programs to ensure all students graduate with the skills, motivation, curiosity, and resilience needed to succeed in college and career and become responsible participants in tomorrow's society. These Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded schools expand the district's K-12 STEAM pathway and sustain the district's professional development initiatives that advance systemic reforms. The MSAP schools serve large numbers of English language learners and students from economically disadvantaged communities. The schools also partner with various industry, higher education, and community organizations. These magnet programs prepare students to be successful in STEAM-related careers and in diverse workplaces through the development of dialogic learning environments that move students from tolerating different perspectives to respecting, valuing, and learning from those differences.

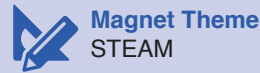

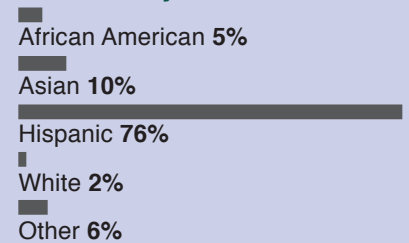

Linda Vista Elementary

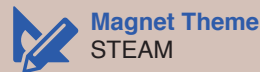

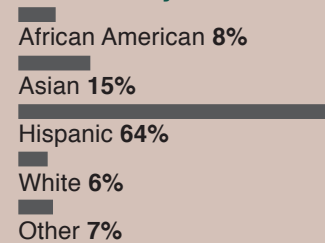
