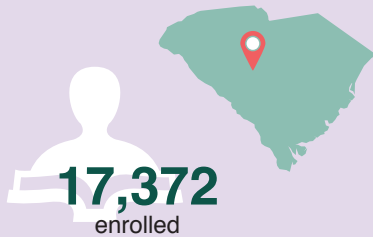

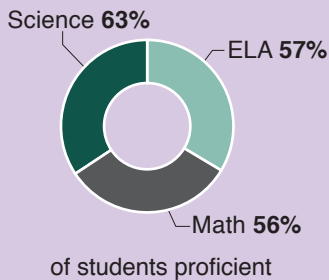
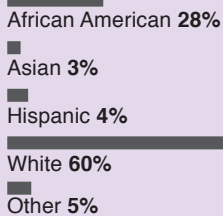

Project Overview

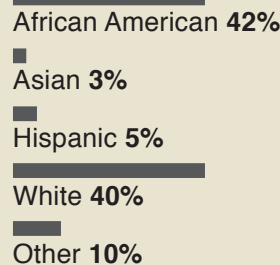
School District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties is creating two new partial magnet programs, one in an elementary and one in a high school; converting an elementary school from a traditional program to a magnet program; and significantly revising an elementary school. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project is reducing minority group isolation and increasing socioeconomic diversity; using research-based approaches to raise student academic achievement; and promoting interaction among students from various socioeconomic, racial, and ethnic backgrounds. Community partnerships support rigorous programs of study, personalized learning, and innovative theme-based curricula to support college and career readiness.

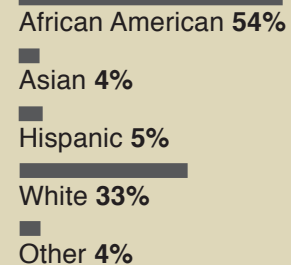

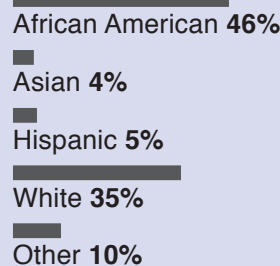

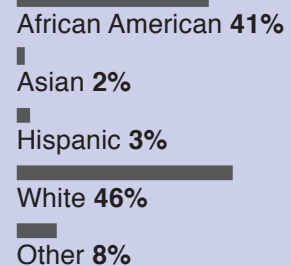
